

### 3. EXPRESSED SPACE NEEDS

Based on our research and discussions with Jeudevine Trustees, GBA prepared individual program sheets for each function in the building. These follow in section 4. It is clear that the needs of the library are consistent. GBA then used the program sheets which include proposed space sizes to generate a preliminary building program and an area projection for the entire building.

#### **Expressed space needs:**

- Full accessibility.
- Expanded space for collections and programs for all ages.
- Space for Community Meetings.
- Meeting space for tutoring, organization meetings, study groups and small business use.
- Activity area for crafts, maker space, etc.
- Quiet areas for individual study, contemplation and recharging.
- Additional computer spaces allowing more privacy.
- Kitchen area.
- Youth library with dedicated computers.
- Children's library with dedicated computers.
- Adult library with current books, reading room and break away areas for private studies.
- Librarian control center and work space.
- Display area for new books.
- Staff work room/lounge/lunch room.
- Custodial work space.
- Adequate storage.
- A discreet lactation area.
- Outdoor area that brings outside in and inside out
